RoDTEP Scheme: Is it worth the wait?

he long-anticipated guidelines for Remission of Duties and Taxes for Export Products (RoDTEP scheme) were announced on August 17th, 2021 which will be in effect since January 1st, 2021 is replacing the MEIS scheme along with rates for products covering 8555 tariff codes. While the rates range from 0.5% to 4% for various products it is substantially lower than the rate of incentive available under the MEIS scheme for the various product categories. The scheme aims to refund duties/taxes/levies at central, state and local level borne on exported goods which is otherwise not refundable under any other law. The rebate will be computed in the as a percentage of FOB value of the exported products (similar to MEIS scheme) with a value cap per unit of the exported product



chemical industries were excluded from getting the benefits of RoDTEP which is said to impact their competitiveness in the export market. Another set of exclusions from RoDTEP scheme is that companies claiming benefits under other export benefit schemes such as Advance Authorisation, SEZ, EOU and MOOWR scheme are restricted from claiming the benefit. Exclusion of these schemes from the **RoDTEP** notification may cause a big setback, as such restriction was not there under the MEIS scheme. However, it has been stated that RoDTEP rates and exclusion of some of these schemes would be decided based on the recommendations of the RoDTEP committee. Hence, there is still hope for schemes such as EOU, SEZ and Advance






